

#### CHERRY TOMATO: SUNGOLD

Hybrid cherry tomato. Beautiful orange coloring. Typically called candy by those who grow it; prolific producer. Strong disease resistance.






#### CHERRY TOMATO: PINK BUMBLEBEE

Cherry tomato with pink skin and gold streaks. Sweet flavor. Beautiful color. The streaks help you know when the fruit is ripe!






#### CHERRY TOMATO: SUNRISE BUMBLEBEE



TOMATO: BLACK KRIM (HEIRLOOM)

Heirloom slicer that has a beautiful dark color and is wonderfully juicy for tomato sandwiches! Disease resistant and high yield.

Heirloom slicer. German Johnson produces good size tomatoes. Very flavorful. More pink in color.

TOMATO: STRIPED GERMAN (HEIRLOOM)

Heirloom slicer. Yellow and red coloring, making this a very attractive tomato. Excellent flavor and fruit texture is different from other tomatoes. Large fruit that is less acidic.





TOMATO: AMISH PASTE (HEIRLOOM)

Heirloom Paste tomato. Large plum fruit that is great for pasta sauces! Also a good option for salsa making.







TOMATO: SAN MARZANO (HEIRLOOM)

Heirloom Paste Tomato. Excellent flavor for canning, salsas, pasta sauces, etc but can also be eaten raw. Unique fruit shape. Doesn't crack easily so you have a long harvest window.

#### TOMATO: CELEBRITY

Hybrid tomato with a uniform, quintessential red tomato look. Disease resistant and DETERMINATE, meaning it has a window of production and is more compact. Great for container growing.

#### TOMATO: SKYWAY

Hybrid slicer. Large fruited red tomato, great for sandwiches. Disease resistant and DETERMINATE, meaning it has a window of production and is more compact. Great for container growing.



TOMATO: BIG BEEF PLUS

Hybrid Slicer. This beefsteak tomato has the quintessential red ripe slicer tomato look, and has been bred to have a better resistance to diseases present in hot humid climates.

#### SWEET PEPPER: JIMMY NARDELLO

Italian sweet pepper with a rich, sweet pimento-ish pepper flavor. Perfect for grilling or roasting, and is an excellent producer in the garden. Once they start coming in, harvest when half the fruit is red and half green, and the fruit will continue to ripen in your kitchen.

#### SWEET PEPPER: LUNCHBOX YELLOW

Perfect for salads and snacking. Similar to a bell pepper but a quicker fruiting plant that are not as prone to blossom rot as the larger fruited peppers are.





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#### SWEET PEPPER: CUPID BELL PEPPER

Cupid bell peppers are the cutest, heart shaped peppers. The plants have dense foliage with lots of branches, which help protect those cutey fruits from sunscald.

#### PEPPER: SHISHITO

These peppers are the length of your finger and have some wavy textures to their shape. They are excellent flash fried in oil and seasoned with salt. Majority of the peppers you'll harvest are <u>MILD</u> but every once in awhile you'll get a hot one!





HOT PEPPER: CAYENNE

Easy to grow, traditional <u>HOT</u> pepper. Great for sauces and marinades. Can also hang dry!







HOT PEPPER: JALEPEÑO

Jalapeños produce for a long period of time. Excellent canned for when you need heat in the winter. This variety is a hybrid with good disease resistance.

### NADAPEÑO (SWEET)

Can't take the heat? Nadapeno has the same growth habits of a jalapeno plant, but the fruit is not spicy! Cook and use like you would bell peppers and enjoy the mild jalapeno flavor.







HOT PEPPER: HABANERO

Helios is an early fruiting variety that's easy to grow in a container garden. Bring inside if you want to perennialize. Nice waxy orange fruit that are great for making hot sauce - <u>SPICY</u> but flavorful! Expect a large harvest at the end of the season!

Habanada carries the same smokey notes of a habanero pepper but without the heat. Excellent pepper to incorporate into hot sauces.

EGGPLANT: FAIRYTALE

Only 2-3 inches in length, this small fruiting eggplant has a skin that is purple and white striped. These are easy to cook - just cut right in half to grill or roast whole! No bitter skin.

Pick when small!







## EGGPLANT: ORIENT EXPRESS

Deep dark purple skin, light colored flesh. Another excellent choice for grilling, roasting, stir fry. No need to peel skin off, not bitter. Easy to grow!

Slender fruit without bitter skin like an Italian variety. No peeling, easy slicing. Great grilled or roasted.







The only Italian eggplant variety I grow. Fruit is a beautiful purple pink and is 6-7in. Skin is not bitter so no need to peel. Because these are smaller fruits, they are much less likely to scald in the sun while they ripen.









A staple for summer salads, sandwiches and pesto making, this Basil is sure to please. Keep the blooms pinched off and you will harvest all summer. Can tolerate and benefit from afternoon shade.


#### HERB: THAI BASIL

Dark skinned zucchini, Dunja is very disease resistant for Southern growing. Harvest young (fruits grow fast)! Best to grow in pairs for proper pollination so we encourage customers to purchase 2 of the same variety.

#### SQUASH: ZEPHYR

Zephyr is a yellow+green summer squash! Beautiful fruit - pick small and pick often. Can be picked and cooked with flower still on. Flowers can also be harvested alone as they are edible! Best to grow in pairs for proper pollination so we encourage customers to purchase 2 of the same variety.

#### SQUASH: DELICATA

Plant in spring, harvest late summer, early fall. You can eat this winter squash right out of your garden, and the skin is thin enough to consume as well Beautiful yellow fruit with green streaks and a sweet flavor. Vining plant! You will need space for this to spread or a trellis to climb.




This variety of Acorn Squash stores well after harvest and can be stored until you are ready to use later in the fall and winter! These are vining plants and need room to spread out!





#### BEAN: KENTUCKY WONDER



Heirloom variety from the 1800s. Green POLE bean, so have a trellis planned. Great space saver with high yields. Edible raw or cooked, great for freezing. Stringless when harvested young.







#### BEAN: GOLD RUSH

Yellow wax bush bean meaning you don't need a trellis for this to climb. Bushy in habit, prolific producer. Great sweet green bean flavor.

#### BEAN: STRIKE GREEN

Green bush bean that is great for cooking, canning, pickling or freezing. Excellent growth habit and heavy producer. Once you start picking, it just keeps producing! Which makes for lots of jars filled for winter!


#### KALE: BLACK MAGIC

#### NAPA CABBAGE: BILKO

Napa Cabbage heads are layers and layers of light airy juicy stemmed leaves. Harvest will occur quicker if grown in full sun, but can tolerate part shade. Great for Kimchi or Slaw. Leaves are large and can easily be used to make a cabbage roll, stuffed and baked.

#### ARUGULA


in the fall.
